Why Fiberglass?

Security

- When it comes to the performance of entry doors, research shows that security is the No. 1 concern of homeowners.
- While steel entryways are generally perceived as the most secure against forced entry, in reality, Therma-Tru Smooth-Star® fiberglass doors with security strike plates exceeded the industry's highest level by 40 percent. (*ASTM F-476 Section 18 Grade 40.*)

Energy Efficiency

- The polyurethane foam core in our doors offers as much as four times the insulation value of most wood doors. (*Comparison of fiberglass to wood doors, both without glass.*)
- Fiberglass doors are thermal "neutral," meaning they don't react to cold and heat. Steel-edged, steel doors are five times as thermally conductive as fiberglass, resulting in higher thermal losses in steel-edged products. In other words, cold air can leak inside and heat can escape outside, or vice versa depending on the season.

Performance

- Fiberglass doors offer better durability and require less maintenance than wood or steel doors. Wood absorbs moisture so it can peel, bow, warp, rot or twist. Wood is also vulnerable to fading from sunlight.
- Steel doors easily dent and scratches can lead to rust.
- Rust is particularly problematic for steel in geographic areas where corrosive salt is used to clear streets, highways, walkways and driveways. Lawn fertilizer can also damage steel doors.
- Steel is also prone to paint chipping.

Why Fiberglass? (Continued)

Aesthetics

- Fiberglass doors have the authentic, high-end look of real wood. It's virtually impossible to discern the difference.
- Compared to steel, the embossment detail on fiberglass doors is far richer.
- Steel is cold to the touch while fiberglass has the warm touch and has the feel of wood.

Return on Investment

Overall, fiberglass tends to deliver a better long-term return on investment than either wood or steel.

- Wood doors are often more expensive than fiberglass and need more regular maintenance.
- Heavier gauge steel doors are actually more expensive than Therma-Tru's Smooth-Star[®] fiberglass doors and, again, potentially require more maintenance.
- More than 94 percent of Therma-Tru's fiberglass door systems are ENERGY STAR[®] qualified and can save more energy than wood doors and many brands of steel doors.

"Remodeling" magazine recently conducted its annual survey to determine which remodeling projects give homeowners the greatest return on their investment.

- For the second year in a row, entry door replacement ranked as the No. 1 most valuable remodeling project with a return of 102 percent.
- Entry door replacement was the only project that earned a ROI of over 100 percent.
- The study results reinforce an important message: enhancing your entry door will likely improve your home's value, its energy efficiency and add to its curb appeal – important in a housing market with more sellers than buyers.

Homeowners want more than a beautiful entryway – they want energy efficiency. That’s exactly what Therma-Tru entry and patio door systems offer, in any region or climate zone. In fact, more than 94 percent of Therma-Tru products are ENERGY STAR® qualified and Natural Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC) Certified, helping homeowners save money on energy costs by providing superior energy efficiency.

Here are just some of the features that help our doors earn their ENERGY STAR rating:

- **A polyurethane foam core.** Therma-Tru fiberglass doors offer up to four times* the insulation of most wood doors due to their solid polyurethane foam core. This essentially creates an energy efficient envelope for the home, stabilizing the interior temperatures and therefore decreasing energy costs. (**Comparison of fiberglass to wood doors, both without glass*)
- **Energy-efficient glass.** All of the decorative glass in our doors, sidelites and transoms is sealed between two panes of tempered glass. This important design feature contributes to the excellent thermal properties necessary to qualify for ENERGY STAR
- **Complete systems.** Therma-Tru doors are designed as complete systems with components that work together. This ensures a very tight seal and provides additional energy savings

- Therma-Tru’s patented AccuGrain® technology gives our top-of-the-line wood grained Classic-Craft® fiberglass door systems an accurate representation of every detail of the grains, texture and feel of premium woods. Green Building

Therma-Tru products can help contribute points for the home to qualify for a variety of Green building standards, including:

- **The Green Globes Program** – Because of the inherent energy efficient and durable qualities of Therma-Tru door systems, the doors may qualify for points toward certified green building, depending on which standard the builder uses. For example, in the Green Globes program, Therma-Tru doors may help contribute points for Energy Performance, Reduced Energy Demand, Thermal Comfort and Acoustical Comfort.
- **The LEED™ Program** – In the LEED program, Therma-Tru doors may help contribute points in the “Energy” category with our ENERGY STAR® qualified products, in the “Materials” category for our recycled content and certified renewable wood and composite materials, and in the “Innovation and Design” category for the longevity and warranty of our products. This is because our door systems have been tested for air, water and structural performance.
- **NAHB National Green Building Standard** – Therma-Tru doors may help contribute up points in three sections. Our products may apply to the Resource Efficiency section by requiring no additional finish, using recycled content and containing fewer resources than traditional products such as wood. Therma-Tru products also may apply to the Energy Efficiency section by helping to meet or exceed required energy codes, and being part of an onsite third-party inspection to confirm installation of energy-related features and ensure doors are flashed, caulked and sealed properly. Lastly, our products may contribute to the Indoor Environmental Quality section if the door between the garage and living area is sealed tightly.

Safety & Security

- **Multi-Point Locking Systems** – The Home Safety Council reports that unlocked or improperly locked doors and windows are responsible for nearly half of all home break-ins. Therma-Tru’s Multi-Point Locking System enhances security because the lock engages the frame at several points, rather than only at the strike plate. It also keeps the door panel seated squarely in the frame, ensuring proper alignment and weather sealing even if the house settles.
- **Home Safety Council Awards** – In 2006, Therma-Tru was awarded the Home Safety Council Commendation Award for Product Innovation for Consumer Safety. Awarded for its patented security strike plate, the 20-gauge steel component addresses the weaknesses in a typical door system with significant resistance to forced entry. In 2005, Therma-Tru received the same award for its Classic-Craft® fiberglass door system because of its outstanding performance in harsh weather conditions.
- **Adjustable Security Strike Plate** – Therma-Tru fiberglass door systems are more resistant to forced entry than wood doors and offer an adjustable security strike plate that withstands three times the force of standard strike plates.

Therma-Tru Impact-Rated Entry Products

Impact-rated entry products, including the Lip-Lite Impact-rated glass, Internal Blinds and Opaque Impact-rated doors give homeowners more protection against severe storm damage, including heavy winds, rain, flying debris and break-ins, while maintaining the curb appeal of the home.

- **Opaque Impact-rated doors** are ideal for coastal areas that face tropical storms and are approved for HVHZ and windborne debris zones:
 - Unique design features, which include a steel plate core, provide added strength and rigidity to withstand heavy-duty impacts
 - Passed a large missile impact test (prevents nine pound object fired at 35 mph from penetrating.)
 - Structural performance of up to DP-100 (equivalent to 236 mph winds)

Two of the leading concerns homeowners have about decorative glass are related to security and privacy. Homeowners can rest assured that both of these concerns are addressed with Therma-Tru's impact rated glass options and internal blinds.

- **Impact-rated glass** has been approved for installation in windborne debris zone when installed in an Impact-rated door:
 - Approved for the windborne debris zone when installed in a non-impact rated door and approved for HVHZ when installed in an Impact-rated door
 - Features laminated safety glass
 - Scrolled frame with screw channel cover
 - Passed a large missile impact test (prevents nine pound object fired at 35 mph from penetrating)
 - Structural performance of up to DP-55 (equivalent to a 75 mph winds)
 - Options include: grilles between glass, decorative glass, clear glass and clear Low-E glass for improved energy efficiency
- **Internal blinds** provide instant privacy and easy operation.
 - Available in Fiber-Classic® Smooth-Star® and Profiles™ entry and patio doors these blinds are between the panes of glass, so homeowners won't have to contend with dust or damage
 - Fully adjustable to let the desired amount of light in or can be closed completely for ultimate privacy

Curb Appeal and Perceived Value

Consumers believe an attractive front entrance not only adds to a home's curb appeal, but can also boost its perceived market value:

- In a survey of homebuyers, 2,400 consumers were asked to estimate the value of various homes based on exterior appearance. The study found that consumers believed that a home with an enhanced entryway added to its perceived value by as much as five times the cost of the entry system installation.
(Therma-Tru's "National Home Valuation Study" was commissioned by Therma-Tru® in 2002 and conducted by TNS, an independent provider of Internet-based research and research-based marketing information and counsel).
