And now, as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, homeowners are eligible to receive a tax credit equal to 30% of the product cost – up to \$1,500 per household for all energy efficiency improvements combined – when they purchase and install qualified products now through 2010.

How do you qualify?

- § Purchase and install a qualified Therma-Tru product from 2009 through 2010.
- § Products must have both a U-Factor and Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) of 0.30 or lower.
- § Save the sales receipt and the Manufacturer Certification Statement (can be found at www.thermatru.com) for your tax record keeping.
- § The tax credit must be claimed for the year the qualified product was purchased and installed.
- § The product must be installed in taxpayer's principal residence.
- § **Labor/installation costs are NOT eligible. Taxpayer is advised to consult a tax professional to confirm eligibility.**
