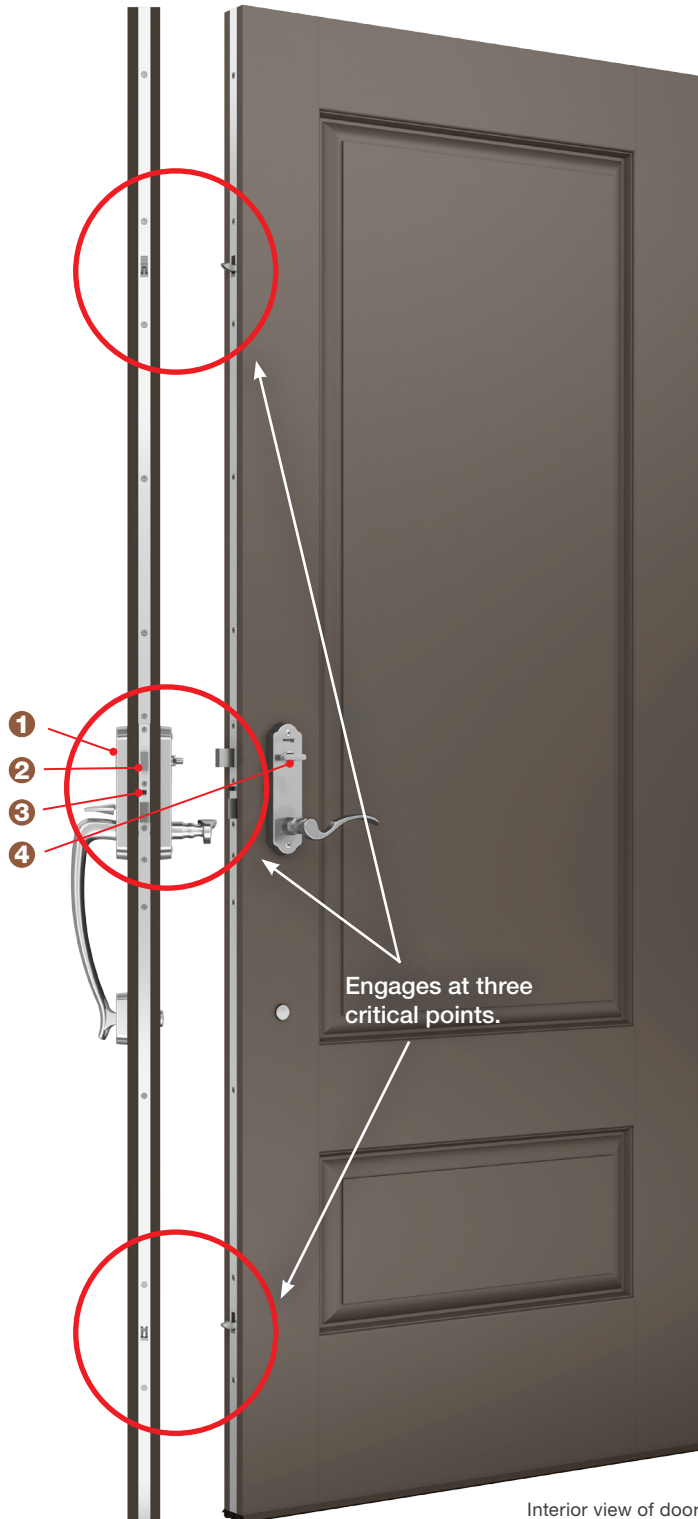

Engages at three critical points.

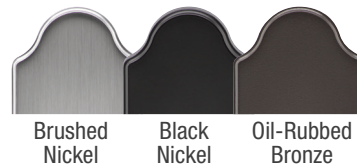

## Tru-Advantages

- From traditional to contemporary, there is an MPLS that fits several home styles. Lever and grip-style handlesets bring on-trend aesthetics, and multiple finish options allow homeowners to customize their entries.
- Give homeowners a locking system with functionality that's as easy to use as a traditional deadbolt, but provides security along with great sealing and curb appeal.
- Larger doors tend to bend away from the weatherstrip causing air to leak into a home. A multi-point lock helps prevent this from happening in 6'8" and 8'0" doors by keeping it tight against the weatherstrip.
- An integrated mishandling device ensures the three locks can only be engaged when the door is closed - protecting the frame from becoming damaged.
